The following classes will run in conjunction with Summer School.

Intro to Psychology:

PSY101 is a college class being taught by Mrs. Ross. She will be meeting with the class one day a week. Other work will be done online, in between classes. This is a requirement for many college majors, especially health care and education. This will count as an elective toward your High School Graduation Requirements.

Career and College Prep CCP:

This class fulfills the Graduation Requirement for CCP. The class will run for three weeks. In addition to exploring career pathways, there will be guest speakers and field trips to colleges and businesses.

HVAC/Plumbing:

This is a one-week introduction to HVAC/Plumbing. Students will be transported to KVCC for the class. This class will run June 24th to June 28th from 8-12. Students will learn how to plumb a new bathroom, rebuild an oil burner, solder, learn about HVAC and heat pumps. Students will tour the campus and talk to college counselors about opportunities in the skilled trades.
