- Check your school email every day as this is the primary way we will communicate with each of you.
- Bi-weekly we will release packet and online work that is now becoming more course-specific. We recommend that if you are able to complete this work and share it back with your teachers - they will provide feedback. This work will not be graded, but you need to know that your teacher will mark this work in their grade book as collected. We are in hopes that you continue to stay connected and continue to learn new content for that course.
