In conclusion, we are holding March 13 as the last day academic grades are being entered into PowerSchool. One exception is that our Advanced Placement and college dual enrollment courses will continue to move forward. Here are some very important things you can do to help yourself end this school year on a positive note: Work with your teachers in courses where you may have missing assignments. Staff will be allowing you to remediate those assignments. Please check your school email every day as we will use this as the primary way to communicate with each of you.
