FYI - Students who are considering admission to **any school** in the **Maine Community College System (KVCC, EMCC, CMCC, SMCC, etc)** need the following test scores for admission.

Verbal SAT score of 480 or greater

Math SAT score of 500 or greater for college algebra, STEM math, or Statistics

Math SAT score of 480 or greater with a full year of college prep math your senior year for college algebra, STEM math, or Statistics

Math SAT 480 or greater for Quantitative Reasoning or Technical Math

Mat SAT SAT score of 450 or higher with a full year of college prep math your senior year for Quantitative Reasoning or Technical Math
