Mandated State testing of all juniors in reading and math will take place on Thursday, May 13 for K-Z students and Friday, May 14 for A-J students. **All remote students will test Thursday.** Testing will take all of blocks one and two. Remote students will receive a zoom link from Miss Brown who will be leading the remote testing. All K-Z and A-J students will be assigned to a test room. Test room assignments will be posted in the main hall by the guidance office and the media center. Students are required to report to their test room by 8:15 on their test day. Every-day students will test on the day that aligns with their last name and students who attend off-alphabet will need to look carefully for their name on a list for the day they are here. Every-day students will report to the media center on their non-testing day. **Bring your school computer to your test.** It is recommended that you bring something to drink, a snack and homework to do or a book to read.
