The E. James and Eileen Ferland Engineering Excellence Scholarship – students are required to maintain satisfactory academic performance and major in mechanical, civil, electrical, computer, chemical, bioengineering or engineering physics at the University of Maine. To be considered for a scholarship, students must apply to attend UMaine.
