**The E. James and Eileen Ferland Engineering Excellence Scholarship** – students are required to maintain satisfactory academic performance and major in mechanical, civil, electrical, computer, chemical, bioengineering or engineering physics at the University of Maine. To be considered for a scholarship, students must apply to attend UMaine.

**Nathan Gronda Scholarship** – applicants must be pursuing a degree in Engineering and have a minimum GPA of 85. April 1 deadline.

**SAHS Girls Soccer Scholarship** – applicants must have played soccer all four years at SAHS and have a minimum GPA of 85. April 15 deadline.

**SAHS Football Boosters Scholarship** – applicants must have completed in at least two years of high school football and have a minimum GPA of 80. May 1 deadline.

**Peter S. Finley Memorial Scholarship** – applicants must be pursuing a degree at Maine Maritime Academy. May 1 deadline.

**W. Edward Jordan, Jr., MD Scholarship** – applicants must be pursuing a degree in Biology, Nursing, Physical Therapy, Nutrition and/or a related discipline at a post-secondary institution in Maine. Applicants must have a minimum GPA of 85. April 15 deadline.

**North Cornville Ladies Aid Scholarship** – applicants must be residents of Cornville. May 1 deadline.

**The Marion Knight Memorial Music Scholarship** – applicant must be a senior member of a SAHS sponsored music ensemble for two or more years, in good standing, who has demonstrated ensemble and solo musicianship, leadership ability, and intends to pursue a college program leading to a bachelor's degree. April 1 deadline.

**SAHS Boys Basketball Boosters Award** – applicants must have participated in boys' basketball for a minimum of two year and have a minimum GPA of 85. April 30 deadline.

**Phyllis Breard Memorial Scholarship** – applicants must be graduates of SAHS ***and*** must have completed a program at SCTC. Applicants must be pursuing a health care related degree. May 1 deadline.

**Carrabassett Masonic Lodge Scholarship** – applicants must be residents of Canaan. May 1 deadline.

**Eaton-Norridgewock Alumni Association Scholarship** – applicants must be residents of Norridgewock, Smithfield or Mercer. April 15 deadline.

**M.S.A.D. #54 Education Association Scholarship** – applicants must be planning to pursue a degree in education. May 1 deadline.

**SAHS Girls Basketball Scholarship** – applicants must have played basketball for all four years of high school and have a minimum GPA of 85. April 30 deadline.

**Gleason Brothers Memorial Scholarship** – applicants must be residents of Canaan. May 1 deadline.

**Glen Holden Music Award** – applicants must have participated in the MSAD #54 music program for four years and have a minimum GPA of 85. Applicants must have attended all rehearsals and performances. April 1 deadline.

**Sandra Hovey Memorial Voice Music Scholarship** – applicants must be members of the SAHS vocal program for two years or more, in good standing, who have demonstrated solo ability, leadership ability and seek to pursue a career in the field of music as a vocal teacher or performer by enrolling in a college program offering a bachelor's degree in the same. April 1 deadline.

**Marion Knight Memorial Music Scholarship** – applicants must be members of a SAHS sponsored music ensemble for two or more years, in good standing, who have demonstrated ensemble and solo musicianship, leadership ability and intend to pursue a college program leading to a bachelor's degree.
