Friends and Family of Aaron Sterling-Open to Skowhegan Area High School pursuing a full-time post-secondary program in Political Science, Public Policy, Public Management or Public Administration. **April 3rd deadline**

Boys' Soccer Boosters- Up to four \$250 scholarships to be awarded to a boys' soccer player who's played soccer all 4 years and has a GPA of 85 or higher. A write-up about their future plans and how soccer has impacted their high school experience is required. **Deadline, April 1**
